## Big Health Forum on the Belt and Road

## 1. Background and Objectives

People-to-people bonds is one of five major cooperation areas for the Belt and Road initiative to promote exchanges and dialogues between different cultures. Big health industry is a cluster of different industries, for which the core industry is food industry, the periphery industries are related to planting, breeding, service, tourism, pension and so on. The cooperation may initiate from big health industry and gradually extend to big data, new energy and materials, and environmental protection within 5 to 10 years.
